## Managing your waste

Find out at the reception desk where the sorting stations are located and what materials are collected (recycling, composting, etc.) and use bags to sort your materials directly at your site.

IMPORTANT: Waste does not go into the fire pit!



Do not leave your appliances on unnecessarily when you are not using them or when you are away (e.g., air conditioning). Your RV is a small space that cools down quickly and easily. Use electricity responsibly!

## Use of the vehicle

Do you want to get around the campground? Choose an active mode of transportation: walking or biking are healthy, safe and good for the planet!

## Water pollution

Soapy water doesn't go into nature, let alone the waterways. Instead, dispose of it at the washroom sinks. Also, choose biodegradable and phosphate-free dish soap and laundry soap to preserve nature.

IMPORTANT: Under no circumstances should you dispose of your wastewater into the environment.

#### Water consumption

When washing dishes or brushing your teeth, do not let the water run unnecessarily. Also, consider adding water aerators to your faucets. In addition to reducing your water consumption, they do not change the pressure of the jet. Try it and you'll love it!

## Buy local

Why not take advantage of your stay to discover the local flavors? Ask at the campground reception desk for places where you can taste the specialties of the region. This way, you will encourage small businesses and reduce the GHGs associated with your meals. Enjoy your meal!

# Reduce your waste

To reduce your waste, start by banning the use of single-use products (plastic water bottles, cardboard coffee cups, disposable dishes, etc.) and replace them with reusable containers. And why not borrow your neighbor's tools to avoid buying unnecessary items?
